



The Portsmouth Community Foundation offers the following scholarship opportunities, place a check mark by each scholarship for which you are applying:

- Armed Forces Scholarship**: \$1,000 for the dependent of active duty enlisted (E1-E9) Coast Guard or Navy personnel **stationed** in Portsmouth, Virginia,; graduating high school senior; accepted or enrolled in an ACE accredited community college, four-year college or university with a GPA of 3.0 or better. As of 2009, the award will be a two-year scholarship, providing the recipient meets with renewal criteria of a GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- Josef D. Collins Memorial Scholarship**: \$500 for I.C. Norcom High School graduates pursuing a post-secondary education primarily in a Science or Arts program are eligible to apply. Selection will be based on the following criteria: financial need, academic performance, community service.
- Foskey-VanDyck Scholarship**: Available to Portsmouth and Chesapeake Western Branch high school seniors pursuing higher education at James Madison University majoring in music education, music, or other with a preference in that order.
- Dwight and Dorothy Humphrey Memorial Scholarship**: \$1,000 available to Army Corps of Engineers Norfolk, Virginia employee dependents seeking full-time status at a Virginia ACE Accredited institution of higher learning. GPA 3.0 or better.
- Mike Moreland Humanitarian Rotary Memorial Scholarship**: Available for anyone seeking higher education with a proven record of volunteerism and humanitarianism.
- Thelma J. Murray Memorial Scholarship**: \$1,000 available to (in order of preference) I.C. Norcom High School graduate, resident of Cavalier Manor, member of Morning Star Baptist Church, and record of multiple community service projects seeking full-time status at an ACE Accredited institution of higher learning. GPA 3.0 or better required.
- Horace Savage Scholarship**: \$1,000 available every other year (2009, 2011, 2013, etc.). I.C. Norcom High School graduates attending a Virginia ACE Accredited institution of higher learning.
- International Federation of Professional and Technical Engineers Local #1 Ralph McElfresh Memorial Scholarship**: \$1,000 open to Local #1 employees, retired employees, and their children and grandchildren.
- Robert Smith Memorial Scholarship**: \$1,000 - available to Portsmouth public high school seniors who have participated in the high school athletics program and who have shown athletic promise. The scholarship rotates between Portsmouth public high schools: 2009 I.C. Norcom; 2010 Wilson High; 2011 Churchland High.
- W. Clayton Robertson Memorial Scholarship**: Available to Portsmouth public high schools and Western Branch High School seniors attending Clemson University OR a Virginia Resident attending Medical College of Virginia; and a GPA of 3.0 or better.

Required Documentation:

- Official high school transcript and SAT/Achievement scores
- Two letters of reference
- One page essay describing your educational dream, how you plan to impact the future; and any special circumstance or information that may be helpful to the selection committee.
- Additional essay required for: W. Clayton Robertson Memorial Scholarship on why you wish to attend Clemson University or Medical College of Virginia, and Foskey-VanDyck Scholarship: What is your goal and what support system do you have to achieve your goal? Why you have chosen music or music education as your focus?
